

Rally changes effective September 1, 2023

Rally Introduction class has been added to the courses that will be used. Upon completion of 3 qualifying scores of 70 (170 in WCRL-Cynosport) or better, the title Rally Obedience Introduction - ROI – is awarded.

Rally – Changes effective March 1, 2020

The Show Chair will specify that UKC, AKC, or Cynosport (WCRL) rules will be followed, and will be announced in the premium for each show. Only Novice courses will be used. Dogs 6 months of age or older are eligible to compete for titles.

Rally competition is open to any Windsprites; Smooth Windsprites of Longhair descent; and % Windsprites (50% or greater Windsprite) WHO ARE 6 MONTHS OF AGE OR OLDER. These dogs may be intact or altered.

TITLES:

Rally Obedience Introduction – ROI - 3 legs with qualifying scores of 70 (170 in WCRL-Cynosport) or better

Rally Obedience Novice - RON – 3 legs with qualifying scores of 70 (170 in WCRL-Cynosport) or better

Rally Obedience Advanced - ROA – a total of 6 legs, any 3 of which will have scores of 80 (180 in WCRL-Cynosport) or better

Rally Obedience Champion - ROCH – a total of 9 legs, any 3 of which will have scores of 90 (190 in WCRL-Cynosport) or better

There will be separate classes for Puppies (age 6 months to less than 12 months) and Veteran Dogs (age 9 years and over) regardless of what organization's rules are used.

You may enter any class F.E.O. (for exhibition only - no ribbons or placements).

“Training” in the ring WILL be permitted for dogs competing F.E.O: clickers, treats, toys allowed, but NO harsh corrections will be permitted! (Please be very careful to not drop any food on the ground which could distract another participant.)
